- 1) Phone
- 2) Address
- 3) Items desired
- 4) Method of payment (cash, check, Venmo, PayPal)
- 5) Pharmacy Location (if prescription)

Please do not enter additional information in this email. Other information can be provided when you are contacted by a volunteer.

Keep in mind that the more methods of payment you consider, the more volunteers may be available to service your request.

Once you send the email, you should momentarily receive an auto-response with the details of how the volunteer process works. Please check your junk/spam folder if you do not get it right away.

These times can be emotionally difficult for some people, especially for those that do not handle well living in isolation. Therefore, in addition to providing assistance for grocery shopping and pick-ups, a couple of volunteers, with limited availability, could also provide other types of help, including emotional support and organizing virtual or physical distanced activities.
